

Illinois State Board of Education/Department of Public Health Student Physical Health, Dental, and Vision Exam Requirements

- All documents **MUST** be uploaded to your MCMA account, emailed to the office, or delivered in person **BEFORE** the first day of school. ****In accordance with Illinois State Board of Education regulations, written confirmation from a doctor's office (on office letterhead and with a signature) with notice of a scheduled appointment is permitted in the event that an appointment can not be made before the start of the school year. Completed forms **MUST** be submitted promptly following the appointment.*
- All required document submissions must be dated within **ONE YEAR** prior to the start of the school year and fulfill **ALL** the requirements for the designated age and grade level.
- Medical and religious exemptions for the following exam requirements **MUST** be signed by a doctor and submitted to the school office in accordance with Illinois State Board of Education/Department of Public Health regulations.

ALL NEW STUDENTS:

Must submit a Physical Health Exam, Vaccination Record (or doctor signed exemption), and Birth Certificate. ****If your child is entering (or has completed) Kindergarten, 2nd, or 6th grade see the below requirements.*

ALL KINDERGARTEN STUDENTS:

Must submit a Physical Health Exam, Vaccination Record (or doctor signed

exemption), Dental Exam, and Eye Exam.

ALL SECOND GRADE STUDENTS:

Must submit a Dental Exam.

ALL SIXTH GRADE STUDENTS:

Must submit a Physical Health Exam, Vaccination Record (or doctor signed exemption), and Dental Exam.
